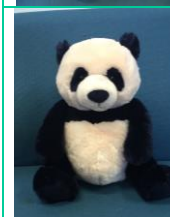
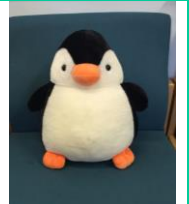

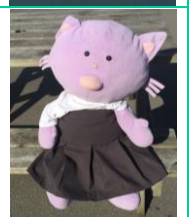
## Celebrating Good Attendance and Punctuality
