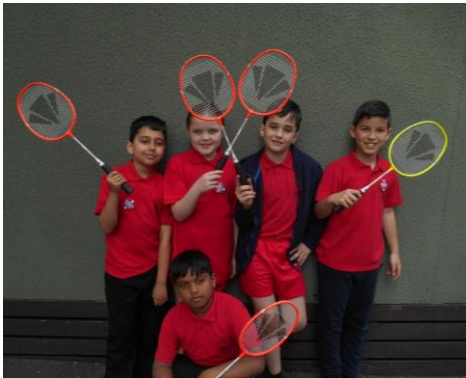


Sport, Sport, Sport!

You Are All Amazing!



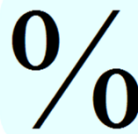
