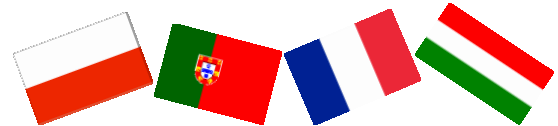

In Term 5 the Arts Team held an assembly to promote Design & Technology (DT). We were very impressed with the level of work that all children have produced this year.
