



# BOURNE COUNTY PRIMARY SCHOOL

## P.E. GRANT EXPENDITURE 2017/2018 REPORT TO PARENTS

### OBJECTIVES

1. Reduce levels of childhood obesity across the school
2. Increase participation in local sports partnership – competitions, events for year groups, training and support for teachers. Additional after school club.
3. Continue training for teaching staff, lunchtime staff and pupil games leaders.
4. Enhanced PE provision across the school.
5. Improved use of professional coaches for after school clubs.
6. Additional hours for support and teaching staff to run lunchtime and after-school clubs.
7. Outdoor and adventurous activity sessions.
8. Access to opportunities for talented pupils.

### IMPACT OF P.E. GRANT 2016-2017

All pupils from Year 1 to Year 6 are encouraged to run a mile twice a week as this has improved across year groups with the introduction of running targets

Coaching and training in a range of activities were offered to staff by specialist teachers, leading to increased confidence in the teachers, and higher-quality provision for pupils

Gifted and talented gym club and dance club provided throughout the year

The gifted and talented gym club participated in a regional competition. Various medals were awarded to the pupils including some gold medals.

There has been an increase in the attendance of local competitive sports sessions and events including:

Inter house competitions have continued in the school for Sports Days, resulting in exposure to, and increased levels of, competition for children of all ages

Resources have been reviewed and increased to improve the provision across the school
