P.E. GRANT EXPENDITURE 2016/17 REPORT TO PARENTS

OBJECTIVES

1. Reduce levels of childhood obesity across the school
2. Increase participation in local sports partnership – competitions, events for year groups, training and support for teachers. Additional after school club.
3. Continue training for teaching staff, lunchtime staff and pupil games leaders.
4. Enhanced PE provision across the school.
5. Improved use of professional coaches for after school clubs.
6. Additional hours for support and teaching staff to run lunchtime and after-school clubs.
7. Outdoor and adventurous activity sessions.
8. Access to opportunities for talented pupils.

IMPACT OF P.E. GRANT 2015-2016

All P.E. lessons observed were judged to be good with some outstanding

All pupils from Year 1 to Year 6 are encouraged to run a mile twice a week

Coaching and training in a range of activities were offered to staff by specialist teachers, leading to increased confidence in the teachers, and higher-quality provision for pupils

Gifted and talented gym club, dance club and football club provided throughout the year

-The gifted and talented gym club participated in a regional competition. We had three gold medal and one bronze medal wins including the girls team, the boys and the year 6 girls trio.

Attendance of local competitive sports sessions and events including:

- Year 1 & 2 Football competition
- Year 5 & 6 Swimming gala
- Year 3 & 4 Tennis festival
- Year 5 & 6 Football competition

Inter house competitions introduced in the school for Sports Days, resulting in exposure to, and increased levels of, competition for children of all ages
