Trip to Michelham Priory



Medication in School

If your child has been diagnosed with asthma, they should have an inhaler in school, as well as one at home. It is important that this is named, and in date.

If your child requires other medication, for example antibiotics, calpol, etc, we are only able to administer medication which has been prescribed by the doctor. It will therefore have a prescription label stuck on it, and will be named for the child. We are unable to administer any other medication. Thank you.
