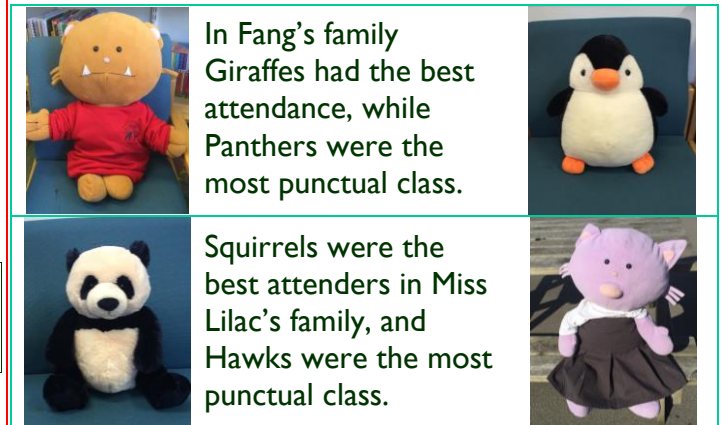
### Climbing Frame Grand Opening
